# 7. County Councillors Report:

Cllr Phil Heaviside advised that good reports are being received from the speed visor now set up within Bournmoor and it appears to be helping with road safety, with drivers more aware of speed. Highways are happy with location and operation.

Money has been put aside to help 1<sup>st</sup> Burnmoor scouts for a PA wireless system, this will help for Remembrance services and any community events, so could be used by Parish Council as well.

A new walkaround us trying to be arranged with wardens, Karbon & interested parties. A date is awaited from Karbon and the council will be informed to see if any of the councillors would like to attend.

a. Police Report - Cllr Willoughby has emailed the police, but had no response back.

## 9. 'Involved & Connected'

- a. Invite to 1<sup>st</sup> Burnmoor Scouts Open Day Gillian Oliver advised the council of the invite to the 1<sup>st</sup> Burnmoor Scouts open day which is being held on 21<sup>st</sup> June. Cllr Morrell and Cllr Wilkinson advised they hoped to attend. Cllr Batt will also be attending.
- b. Leamside Nursey Bournmoor Parish thanked the member of the public that had planted up one of the planters, Leamside Nursery will arrange to complete the other 2 planted areas within the next week. It was noted that a resident had written in to request planting, which would also help prevent parking but BPC would be unable to support this request. Planters approved in locations by DCC, with BPC not owning any land, are already set up across the Parish.
- c. Xmas Tree Cllr Batt is visiting Learnside with Rev Catherine tomorrow and will update at the next meeting about getting a permanent live tree, starting around 8 ft.
- d. Scarecrow Trail Cllr Batt will start advertising for the September event soon, but is awaiting confirmation of a final date. Schools are again keen to take part, money may be needed for printing. Cllr Batt also advised it would be good to bring back the best scarecrow competition, with a judging panel in place from across the community.
- e. Summer Fayre A summer fayre is to held at the Community Centre on 12<sup>th</sup> July, stalls can be arranged for £10 a table. Cllr Batt had looked into bouncy castles, through Candy Kids who have PLI and prices start from £90. Cllr Batt will look into this more and report back for next meeting.

a. The following payments were approved for payment:-

- b. G Oliver presented the formal AGAR paperwork for sign off, following the recent audit, having updated everyone on the accounts at the May AGM. All agreed and the accounts for 24/25 were formally signed off. All paperwork will now be sent into Local Councils by the end of month deadline.
- c. Funding for 1<sup>st</sup> Burnmoor Scouts open day A request had been made from Susan Matthews on behalf of the scout group to seek £150 funding to help with Open Day costs. The proposal to fund the £150 was put forward by Cllr Morell, seconded by Cllr Wilkison and agreed. Cllr Batt abstained from voting, due to her role within the Scout Group.
