1. Chairmans Introduction/Apologies for Absence — Cllr Tait advised that following a process agreed by BPC, each Chair has a period of office for 2 years, before stepping aside and letting a new nominated Councillor take up the reins as Chair and that his 2 year period in this role has now lapsed. Cllr Tait advised that he would like to thank all present for their support and enthusiasm during a difficult period, especially following the loss of the previous clerk Paul Griffin and councillor Malcolm White, and in addition had lost Steve Levitt through ill health. He was pleased that Gillian had stepped into the clerk role and would help keep the Parish on the right lines. Cllr Tait also advised he was proud of how the council had managed through covid, with zoom meetings or with social distancing in place,

- **5.** Annual Wage Review (Clerk) It was agreed to defer the wage review of the clerk, until information was received from CDALC about any pay agreements.
- **6.** Account Balances The Clerk advised that the End Of Year Balance for BPC as of 31 March 2021 was £38348.54. End of Year AGAR Paperwork would now be prepared and externally audited, prior to submission to the Local Council.
